SAFETY AND HEALTH POLICY STATEMENT

The Private Secondary Education Authority is committed to ensuring that all employees and other persons working on the Authority's premises work in a safe and healthy work environment that is as far as is reasonably practicable to prevent personal injury and protect everyone from foreseeable work hazards.

To achieve this, the Authority undertakes to:

1. comply with the Occupational Safety and Health Act (2005) and other relevant regulations;
2. provide sufficient information, instruction and supervision to ensure safety and health at work of its employees and their contribution to their own safety and health at work;
3. reduce all the safety and health risks arising from work activities;
4. ensure that employees and their representatives are consulted in all matters relating to safety and health;
5. prevent workplace accidents and cases of work related ill health; and
6. conduct investigations into all reported incidents.

All employees- irrespective of their position- will:

- take reasonable care to ensure good safety and health procedures are implemented at all times;
- identify and support measures to eliminate or minimise unsafe conditions; and
- assume personal responsibility for their own safety and for those of other work colleagues by always operating in a safe and appropriate manner.
